<b>PURPOSE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Celebrate a once in a lifetime event – the Queen’s Platinum Jubilee</li> <li>Provide a wonderful, lifelong memory for our children</li> <li>Bring our generations back together to mark this historic occasion</li> </ul>	
<b>DATE</b>	Friday 27 <sup>th</sup> May 2022	
<b>LOCATION</b>	Alveston’s field at the back of the school	
<b>START TIME</b>	12.00 entrance; 12.30 performance start	
<b>FINISH TIME</b>	3.15pm, school grounds close at 3.30pm	
<b>ORGANISATION</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parents, grandparents &amp; siblings are invited to join us from 12.00.</li> <li>Gates will open from 12.00 and close at 12.25.</li> <li>The event, to be held outside, will proceed whatever the weather. Umbrellas &amp; waterproof clothing may therefore be required.</li> <li>You may bring additional shelter – such as gazebos – but these must be placed around the fenced edges of the field only.</li> <li>Dress Code – we invite all family members to embrace the red, white and blue theme to make it a spectacular visual sight for our children.</li> </ul> <p><b>Performance</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All classes will participate in a Jubilee Performance starting at 12.30.</li> <li>Children will perform on stage; other classes will sit in front of stage.</li> <li>Parents may sit behind the classes. This area will be clearly marked.</li> <li>Parents may sit on the grass, their own blankets or their own chairs.</li> <li>Families will be invited to join in with some songs too!</li> <li>The performance is expected to finish by 1.30pm</li> </ul> <p><b>Picnic</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After the performance, children may join their families for a picnic.</li> <li>Where families cannot attend, children will picnic together with staff.</li> <li>Children can order a Deli Bag from school if they prefer. Please order these by completing the form which will be sent by the office by Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May.</li> </ul> <p><b>After the Picnic</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Families may take their children home after the picnic before the end of the school day, if they wish.</li> <li>All children leaving before 3.15pm must be signed out by their parent at the school office or at the Knights Lane gate, when it is re-opened.</li> <li>Children with families not attending, or those not going home earlier, must be picked up as normal, at 3.15pm.</li> </ul> <p><b>Housekeeping</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When setting yourselves up on the field please be courteous to everyone around you to ensure everyone has space and everyone can see the performance.</li> <li>Do bring lots of goodies &amp; treats, remembering we are a nut free school.</li> <li>There will be no access to the school building during the afternoon.</li> <li>The toilets in the community room will be available for families and children to use. All children must be accompanied to toilets by an adult.</li> <li>Please make sure you take all your rubbish with you as we do not have the facilities to deal with additional waste.</li> </ul>
